

## Pearl High School Rules for Tailgating



Tailgating is a new tradition at Pearl High School and we are looking forward to an exciting time together. Our goal is to promote a family-friendly and safe environment for everyone involved. To care for fans and the campus, please follow these guidelines in planning your tailgating event.

**Tailgating will be allowed in the Pavilion area only.** The Pavilion is easily accessed by parking alongside Pirate Cove. Grills will be allowed on the concrete area of the Pavilion. Due to the noise level and safety issues, gas operated generators will not be allowed.

Due to school activities taking place and security concerns during school hours, no tailgating activities are allowed until 4:30 PM on game days. All tents and tailgating items must be removed from the property by 11:00 PM. Additional trash receptors will be available.

Space is claimed on a first-come basis. Occupy only the space you need – be considerate of others.

No vehicles are allowed on the grass near the Pavilion.

The PHS campus is a tobacco-free, alcohol-free and drug-free facility. These rules apply to tailgaters also.

**Please help us keep the grounds beautiful – Please stash your trash.**

Do not leave your valuables unattended. Police officers are on patrol, but you are responsible for the items that are left in your tailgating area.

**The teacher's parking lot is a reserved parking area.** A reserved parking spot can be purchased through the Athletic Director's office at 601-939-7063

Restroom facilities are available near the Pavilion at the softball field. All stadium rules apply to tailgaters – once you enter the gates, you cannot leave and return without paying again unless you purchase a Pirate Pass from the Athletic Director.

**No food or drink will be allowed to be taken into the stadium.**
